

## SUBMISSION REGARDING THE FLAT ROCKS WIND FARM

## WILL & HEATHER CARRINGTON-JONES

We would like to state that at this stage we are neither for or against the wind farm but we do have some concerns that we feel need addressing before the Shire makes a decision on whether or not to grant planning permission for the wind farm. We have received conflicting information and on some issues it is difficult to determine what is correct.

## Our concerns are:-

- 1. As there is no final layout for the wind turbines available we are not able to effectively judge the impact they will have on our houses and working conditions on our farm.
- 2. Some publications have indicated that there can be adverse health outcomes if you live within a certain distance of a wind turbine, however without knowing how far it will be to the nearest turbine and whether the information regarding adverse health outcomes is correct we can not make an informed decision.
- 3. We have some concerns regarding the marketability of our property being adjacent to the wind farm.
- 4. In the advent of any adverse outcomes from the wind farm, be it related to health, land values or some other unforeseen problem will the company who owns the wind farm be prepared to negotiate a settlement satisfactory to all parties.
- 5. We would like some clarification regarding no fly zones around the wind farm as this may affect crop spraying operations and recreational flying on and around our property.

We would appreciate being kept informed of the outcomes of concerns raised in the submissions presented to council in order to help us reach an informed decisiøn.
